#### Lessons

- ➤ Event materials are divided into 14 Lessons. The first twelve lessons each have a 20-45 minute video, and the last two lessons include spending one hour with God followed by a time of group discussion and visioning. (Note: Lesson videos are taken from 5 sermons, which are available on the website.)
- ➤ Lessons are a combination of videos, group discussion, and prayer times. The 14 Lessons are designed to be completed in 7 meetings. But this schedule can be adjusted for your group!
- Video messages will be made available online on February 25 and will be accessible after this weekend for future use.
